Stop Motion and Puppetry (Ages 15 and up)

Learn the basics of stop motion filmmaking, the technique that made Gumby and Mr. Bill famous. And learn to make films with similar effect in less time with puppetry techniques. Create characters from clay or paper or existing dolls and action figures. Learn the fundamentals of small scale set design for photo trickery. And also learn the planning and execution which make such projects a success. Create and critique films in a group setting, getting instant feedback on your techniques. (Mac laptops with iMovie preferred but not necessary. Also see companion class “My Life in Miniature.”)



Award-winning photojournalist Stephen Hayford has been documenting community issues since the beginning of his career nearly 20 years ago.
