Hope's annual *Rainbow Trails Camp* is designed for youth, ages 6-17, who have experienced the loss of a loved one during the past year. Camp provides:

- An understanding of the grief process
- Skills to cope with grief and loss of loved one
- An opportunity to be with peers reducing sense of isolation
- A safe, fun day camp experience

Camp Registration

Complete a camp application no later than October 28th. After review, you will receive confirmation that a reservation is held for your camper(s). Please let us know in advance if your plans change so children on the waiting list may be enrolled.

Orientation for Campers/Parents/Guardians

We ask that you attend an orientation via Zoom prior to camp for information about the day.

Day of Camp

Campers arrive to Alliance For The Arts by 9am. Following check-in, camp activities will begin for each age group. Lunch Break between morning and afternoon groups. Campers will conclude activities and pick up at 3pm.
